All new Artisans and Crafters must be juried into the 2021 Jubilee. If you would like to participate in our event please complete the attached form and return it to the committee **on or before May 1st, 2021**. Your request will be judged using the following criteria:

1. **Type of craft,**
2. **Historical relationship to our Appalachian Heritage**
3. **Your ability to demonstrate what you do during the Jubilee**

The Jackson's Mill Jubilee is a heritage arts and crafts event. We are a non-profit organization. All of our crafters are artisans who can display and demonstrate their skill at making the traditional items they create. Not all are asked to do so. All items sold at our event come from products that are (or can be) grown or made and produced in WV and are examples of our rich Appalachian heritage. We do not allow the sale of commercially produced or foreign made items.

This is an outdoor event using tents, barn booths, and pavilions. Our only charge is the booth fee (no commissions). You will be notified of the jury's decision within five (5) business days. If accepted, you will receive an official application for the Jubilee which is due on or before **June 15, 2021**.
