The Jackson's Mill Jubilee is a heritage arts, crafts, and live music event. We are a non-profit organization. All of our crafters are artisans who home make or home grow their product, and can display and demonstrate their skill at making their items. Not all are asked to do so.

All items sold at our event must be homemade or homegrown. We do not allow the sale of commercially produced or resale items.

This is an outdoor event using tents, barn booths, and pavilions. Our only charge is the booth fee (no commissions). You will be notified of the jury's decision within 5 business days. If accepted, you will receive an official registration form for the Jubilee which is due on or before July 28th, 2023.
